BIOPSY SITE INSTRUCTIONS

Date of Biopsy: _____

1. You may take the band aid off tonight or tomorrow.
2. Clean the area at least once a day with soap and water.
3. Apply a thin layer of:

POLYSPORIN

BACITRACIN

OTHER: _____

4. You DO DO NOT need to apply a new band aid daily until healed.

Call the office with any signs of infection

(expanding redness, excessive drainage, increased pain, swelling, or bleeding that does not stop with pressure)

Please note: Your biopsy may be sent to another lab for a second opinion. If this is the case, our office will notify you, billing information will be provided to the lab and you will get a bill from that lab. Results may not be ready for an additional 7-10 business days after the second opinion is sent.

Biopsy results are only given to the patient unless other arrangements are made in advance.

You may access your biopsy results in 7 - 10 business days by logging into your Patient Portal

If your results are not available through the Patient Portal, you may contact the pathology nurse using your Patient Portal e-mail, or call the office where you had the biopsy taken at the number listed below.
